### **Lacrosse Needs Officials to Grow in Iowa Boys & Girls High School Players CAN BECOME Officials**

High School Players can become lacrosse officials AND continue playing for their teams! Junior Officials would work 10U and potentially 12U games in their communities. A per game payment of \$45 is provided and schedulers would clear conflicts with high school games.

The experience will make them better players, they get paid for their effort and they are helping young boys and girls play the game we all love.

To become a Junior Official, your player needs to:

- (1) Contact the Iowa Lacrosse Association so we can have USA Lacrosse grant you access to the E-LEARNING components on their website (and provide the player's name (or US Lacrosse ID#) and a new, unique email address for them that is different from the email on their parent's account. This allows the Jr. Official to login under their own account and get credit for their training (otherwise it can get confused with their parent's account);
- (2) Log into USA Lacrosse and access the online courses and rules exam in their e-learning portal. (After logging in to [MY ACCOUNT](#), just click MENU in the upper right corner and select E-LEARNING).
- (3) Complete the RULES Courses & the Annual Requirements.
- (4) Send Your Completed Certification to Iowa Lacrosse Association.
